


Dear Collective Leaders,




For the on-site course, the programme will be designed with a focus on project or country-specific objectives, including a review and analysis of the project, preparatory interviews with participants, facilitation design and all training material, implementation of the course with two facilitators, debriefing with an option of follow-on capacity building, and a debriefing report with recommendations, all in close communications with your core team.

Training your team on-site can reduce travel costs and makes your planning flexible. We offer this kind of training for 16+ participants and it becomes more affordable the more participants you have. Different projects or organisations can also jointly register to have an on-site training together. You can specify the location, dates, and number of participants (up to 26). Two of our expert trainers will be made available to implement your training.

NEW We also offer hybrid formats of on-site trainings: the CLI trainers will facilitate the sessions by being virtually connected to the training group.

There are three levels of compass application:

- Collaborative Change Maker
- NEW Collaboration System
- In development: Transformation Network

The first level "Collaborative Change Maker" is ready for use: You can identify your collaboration competency pattern to assess your strengths and challenge patterns. You can plan action with the compass to create functional patterns of change, strengthen your leadership for better co-creation, and increase your impact in navigating complex change.

The next level "Collaboration System" is available since 2020. This feature gives you the opportunity to go beyond your personal level, and focus on the team-, organisation-, and collaboration system level.

Feel free to create your free trial account. You have full access to the Collaborative Change Maker and the Collaboration System level there and you can create your own planning apps there.







Accredited Collective Leadership Facilitator

Facilitate Collective Leadership core courses and guide Multi-stakeholder initiatives using Collective Leadership methodologies

Accredited Collective Leadership Facilitators are fully empowered to facilitate CLI core courses and facilitate multi-stakeholder processes using Collective Leadership methodologies. Accredited CL Facilitators may lead their own not-for-profit courses in:



- The Art of Stakeholder Collaboration
- The Art of Leading Collectively

This entails that in addition to undergoing the Certified Collective Leadership Specialist programme, they must successfully organise and co-facilitate their own course supervised and supported by an experienced CLI facilitator. Furthermore, they publish a reflective or applied case study on CLI methodologies.




Throughout all phases of the accreditation process, trainees are responsible for demonstrating to CLI faculty fluency with the Collective Leadership approach, aptitude for facilitation and coaching, and a capacity for personal reflection and growth. In order to become accredited, trainees must also embody values such as inclusivity, respect for diversity, professionalism, and a commitment to contributing to the sustainability movement.



Once accredited, Collective Leadership Facilitators can establish a **Collective Leadership Hub** through which they can enter into project and training collaborations with CLI. The Collective Leadership Hub, the Collective Leadership Facilitator's profile(s), and related courses will all be added to the CLI website.

Training young professionals at the beginning of their careers to become future leaders for sustainability is the goal of the Young Leaders for Sustainability programme. Since 2012, CLI has trained 120 young professionals in YLS. The programme is organized around the six dimensions of the Collective Leadership Compass. The holistic approach of the Compass is always at the centre of the training and enables YLS participants to find suitable solutions to complex sustainability challenges.
